Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Heavy rain over Northern Ireland and western Scotland at first spreading east across all parts by evening. Clearer conditions with showers following from the west, across all but southeast England and East Anglia by evening. The showers becoming wintry over northern areas, significant accumulations over northern hills. Windy with gales, locally severe in north. Temperatures mild at first in south, noticeably colder later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunny spells and showers for many on Sunday, wintry in north, with gales, locally severe in far north where blizzard conditions possible. Mainly dry over southern regions on Monday, heavy rain and milder conditions in the north.
