

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Saturday 10 Mar 2007

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy with rain across northwestern Scotland during much of the day, moderate bursts of rain at times over southwestern upslopes. Rain spreading slowly southeast overnight. Windy across northwestern Britain, especially over coasts and hills. Elsewhere, mainly dry with sunny periods, these becoming more extensive during the afternoon. Mild or very mild in the southeast.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
England and Wales dry at first on Sunday with southeastern Britain remaining dry all day. Rain over northwestern Britain spreading steadily southeast, reaching northern England and western Wales during Sunday evening. The rain band weakening as it continues southeast during Monday. Showers following to the northwest.
