

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain will clear from England, Wales and Northern Ireland this morning, but it will remain windy and cold across much of Scotland with heavy rain and hill snow. Elsewhere will be dry with some warm sunny spells but also some heavy showers. Overnight, rain will continue across Scotland, but elsewhere will be dry with clear spells.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Most places will be fine and dry on Bank Holiday Monday, with some pleasant sunny spells. However, some rain may affect southern parts later. Wet and windy conditions will quickly spread northwards on Tuesday across all areas, followed by sunny spells and blustery showers.
