Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Most places will see a dry day with warm sunny spells. A few showers will affect Kent and Sussex at times though. Winds will pick up in northwest Scotland through this afternoon. Overnight, it will stay dry across England and Wales, but it will turn wet and windy in Scotland and Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Cloud and rain will gradually spread southeast on Friday with brisk winds. It will stay dry and bright in the southeast until early evening though. Winds will ease for the weekend with a good deal of fine, dry and warm weather, barring the odd shower.
