Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
For much of the UK it will be a fine and dry summers day. In the south it will be feeling hot with largely cloud free skies. Whilst northern parts of the UK will be a little cloudier and therefore cooler, there will still be some warm sunny spells here as well.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

The fine and dry weather will continue, with much of the UK keeping the largely clear skies and very warm temperatures. However, an onshore breeze and some mistiness drifting in from the North Sea will lead to the highest temperatures shifting towards the west of England.
