

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A band of rain, sleet and snow across Wales and southern England will spread into central areas and later some parts of northern England. Snow is likely to be heavy at times over parts of Wales and central England, especially on hills. Further north a mixture of wintry showers and sunny spells. Cold in most parts, with strengthening winds.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Cloudy and windy with rain or snow over central and southern parts continuing on Wednesday before edging southwards and turning more generally to snow during Thursday. Staying cold and windy in the north, with occasional wintry showers on both days.
