

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Sunday 07 Sep 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

Fine for most on Sunday, with light winds and plenty of warm sunny spells once any early mist or fog has cleared. A little cloudier across the south at first, but this should clear through the day. However outbreaks of rain, and stronger winds will affect parts of northeastern Scotland. Remaining fine and clear for most overnight, but feeling chilly.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain across northern Scotland will slowly die fade Monday. Otherwise, there will be a good deal of fine weather on Monday and Tuesday. It will feel warm in sunshine with light winds, but the evenings and nights will stay chilly.
