Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A chilly start across northern parts of the UK this morning. Scattered, locally heavy showers continuing elsewhere, but becoming drier and brighter from the north and west as the day progresses. Feeling cool in the northwesterly wind for all. A chilly night to come with a patchy grass frost developing across rural parts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

A north south split developing across the UK through Friday and Saturday. Mainly unsettled across the north with outbreaks of rain at times, especially during Friday. The south will generally be dry with some bright or sunny spells and lighter winds.
