Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A cold, crisp but sunny day for much of the UK after any early fog patches clear. It will gradually cloud over in the far west through the day, ahead of wet weather spreading eastwards later on. This rain will eventually run into cold air to give some snow for a time in northeastern Britain overnight.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Remaining snow will turn to rain before clearing eastern Britain on Monday. Scattered showers will then follow, with some of these wintry on hills. These will be separated by sunny spells, with the best of these likely in the south.
