

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 05 Apr 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain and locally heavy showers in the south should die out by evening. Cloud and patchy rain will spread across Scotland and Northern Ireland. Central areas will be dry though with sunny spells. Overnight, cloud and patchy rain in Scotland and Northern Ireland will continue southwards, but central and southern areas will remain largely clear with a frost forming.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places will be cloudy on Friday with patchy rain in places, although southern Britain should be mainly dry with some brighter spells. By Saturday most places will be cloudy with a chance of showers, these most likely in the north.
