Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
A pulse of locally heavy rain will move from southwest England and southeast Wales, increasingly affecting northern England and eastern Scotland during the afternoon, but easing as it progresses northwards. It will be drier elsewhere, particularly in Northern Ireland and southeast England, with increased sunny spells compared to recently.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday should start damp, with occasional rain in western UK, whereas eastern UK will be drier but often cloudy, with the brightest conditions likely in the southeast. Becoming drier and brighter on Saturday, with increasing sunny spells. It will be mild throughout, with southeasterly winds.
