Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A bright and frosty start across the south. Cloudier in the north with outbreaks of rain. Rain spreading slowly southeast through the day, mainly affecting eastern parts of Britain. Largely cloudy tonight with patchy rain across the north and west, heaviest across western Scotland. Milder than recent nights, though a patchy frost possible across the south where skies clear.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Generally cloudy both days with outbreaks of rain possible, mainly across the north and west. Best of the drier and brighter conditions expected across the south and east with some sunny spells. Breezy for all. Mild and generally frost free overnight.
