

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain or showers, heavy at times, will gradually spread east across England and Wales during the day, with heavy and thundery showers possible over East Anglia this morning. Elsewhere, it should be drier, brighter and fresher with only isolated showers. Rain will clear southeast England overnight to leave drier and clearer spells, but further rain is expected across northern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Occasional rain will continue across Scotland on Wednesday, but it should be drier elsewhere with some brighter spells and only isolated showers. Most places should be dry on Thursday with sunny spells. Temperatures will stay near normal, with light winds.
