

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Drier and brighter for most, with more in the way of sunshine after early rain clears the Southeast. Scattered showers will develop, chiefly towards central and eastern parts, with the odd one turning heavy. By the evening remaining showers will die away, allowing late sunshine for most, although southwestern UK will gradually cloud over ahead of rain moving in overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Mainly rather cool and cloudy on Tuesday, with brisk winds and occasionally heavy rain spreading from southwestern UK, gradually replacing sunny spells and showers in the north and east. Remaining unsettled into Wednesday, with most seeing some occasionally heavy showers.
