Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Rain will affect many southern parts of Britain tomorrow and will become heavy in places. The far south of England should remain largely dry though with some bright periods. Northern parts of the UK should stay largely dry with some pleasantly warm sunny spells, although rain will push into northern Scotland later in the day.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be rather cloudy with outbreaks of rain for many areas. By Saturday rain will be mainly over southern England, with most other areas dry with some bright spells. There may be a rural frost on Friday and Saturday nights where skies clear.
