

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Scattered showers will spread to northern and western areas, these heavy over Scottish hills, Cumbria and northwest Wales with brisk southwesterly winds. Drier further south and east with a few showers, broken cloud and lighter winds. Heavier showers will spread to southern and eastern areas overnight with western areas becoming drier. Becoming misty where skies clear later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Some showers in the far northwest on Thursday, otherwise dry with broken cloud and bright spells. Early morning mist and fog may be slow to clear in some places. Light winds. Similar on Friday with risk of mist, fog and overnight frost.
