Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across southern Scotland and Northern Ireland will edge southwards into Northern England, but becoming light and patchy. Much of England and Wales will remain dry with hazy sunshine, whilst sunny spells follow southwards across Scotland. Tonight, showery rain will edge southwards across England and Wales, but most northern areas will be dry.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Showery rain across England and Wales will clear southeastwards on Thursday with most places having a dry afternoon with some sunshine. Friday will be mostly dry and warm with sunny spells, but wet and windy weather will spread to northwest Scotland.
