Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A dry day across the UK, with almost unbroken sunshine in the south and just a little patchy cloud further north. It will be warm everywhere, with light winds for many, but becoming breezier in the southwest. Overnight, cloud will spread into western areas, with some light rain likely in Northern Ireland by dawn.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Most places continuing dry and warm with plenty of sunshine and generally light winds. Cloudier at times in the north and west with showers or outbreaks of rain, and there is also a risk of a few thundery showers in the southeast on Saturday.
