Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Generally cloudy with spots of light rain or sleet this morning, continuing in the northeast this afternoon. Otherwise drier, brighter conditions in the south will gradually become more widespread. Feeling cold with brisk easterly winds. Some wintry showers in the northeast tonight. Cold with brisk easterly winds and widespread frost.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Cold with brisk easterly winds on Thursday. Widespread, mainly light snowfall will spread northwards across England and eastern Wales, and wintry showers, some heavy, will affect much of Scotland. Largely dry but cloudy, misty and cold on Friday, and milder, wet and windy weather will spread eastwards later.
