Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Cool at first with mist and fog patches quickly clearing. A dry day for many but with a few showers, heaviest of towards the east. Low cloud, rain and drizzle will reach western parts by evening, then move east with the odd heavy burst at times, mainly in the north. Clearing all but the north and far southeast by dawn.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining rain will clear most areas early Friday to leave a mostly dry day with sunny intervals. Cloud and showery rain will hold on in the far southeast until early afternoon. Showers in the northwest Saturday, drier to the southeast.
