

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Monday 06 Sep 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Heavy rain and strong southeasterly winds will spread north across the remainder of Scotland during the day. Winds will be lighter across Northern Ireland, and rain should eventually ease to scattered heavy showers during the afternoon. Sharp, locally thundery showers, and sunny intervals are expected elsewhere, with much lighter winds and temperatures staying around normal.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
It will remain unsettled with further sharp and locally thundery showers, but also spells of sunshine. Bright or sunny spells should be more widespread across southern parts of the UK during Thursday. Winds should remain light and southwesterly, with temperatures staying near to normal.
