Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A fine, dry day for most of the UK. There will be some hazy sunshine at times, mainly over England and Wales, and it will feel cooler in the southeast with a strengthening breeze. The best of the sunshine will be in Scotland and Northern Ireland. Dry and fine overnight but becoming cloudier across southern and central England.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Most areas remaining dry, but generally becoming cloudier for many places with the odd light shower possible at times. However there will still be some good sunny spells. Temperatures will be above average, but feel cooler in the southeast with strengthening winds.
