Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Early mist will clear to leave a mainly dry day with sunny spells for most parts. However, cloud and showery rain over Northern Ireland will slowly move towards western Scotland, Wales and southwest England during the day. Most places should stay dry overnight, especially Wales and central England, with just a few showers later in the south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:  
Mostly bright and dry with occasional cloud and sunshine during Sunday, but a few showery outbreaks of rain are likely in southern England during the morning. Becoming much windier in the north and west later with heavy rain moving slowly eastwards during Monday.
