Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
After a chilly start, most places will see a fine day with plenty of warm sunshine. However, cloud and outbreaks of rain will spread south-eastwards across parts of Scotland and Northern Ireland as the day progresses, this continuing to spread south into northern England overnight. Clear spells will follow, with some showers possible in the far northwest.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Most places remaining fine and dry over the next few days, with plenty of warm sunshine, turning hazy at times. Thicker cloud across the far north of Scotland with outbreaks of rain possible here on Thursday, and perhaps the odd shower on Friday.
