Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
It will be a bright but chilly start in the east of the UK, with a few isolated frost patches quickly clearing. Rain and strengthening winds will push in from the west through the day, giving a risk of severe gales in the north and northwest. Further south it will be breezy with outbreaks of rain.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Tuesday will be a chilly start with a few showers in the north, whilst elsewhere it will be largely fine and dry with a good deal of sunshine. Wednesday will turn more unsettled with rain and strengthening winds.
