Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Fog may be persistent for parts of Scotland. Otherwise, some dry, sunny periods, especially in the north and later in the west, but further showers for many parts, and some more persistent rain in the far southeast. Tonight, a few showers, mainly western coasts. But rain in the southeast will spread across parts of England and Wales, heavy at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

A band of rain will affect parts of Wales and western England on Saturday, heavy at times. Elsewhere, largely cloudy with occasional outbreaks of rain or drizzle. Further rain or showers for many Sunday. Very windy in the far northeast.
