Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A band of rain will spread from western UK, increasingly falling as snow as it moves eastwards across the UK. This will give significant falls of snow for many, particularly in eastern and central Britain, with icy patches possible everywhere.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
An east-west split should develop into the new week, with snow dying out in situ over southeastern UK on Sunday to leave eastern parts then largely dry but cold. Meanwhile western parts will be less cold, with further rain stalling overhead later on Sunday, continuing in some areas into Monday.
