

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 30 May 2016

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Early morning low cloud will gradually retreat to North Sea coasts to leave many with a fine and dry day, particularly across the west. A few showers may affect western Scotland with some heavy downpours in places, whilst in the south-east it will be cloudier and breezier, and it will cool on eastern coasts.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Outbreaks of rain and stronger winds will edge westwards on Tuesday, with some locally heavy bursts at times in the east. Further west it will remain dry but it will also become cloudier here on Wednesday with rain at times, although the north-west will remain dry.
