

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Tuesday 04 Jun 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Fine day with prolonged periods of warm sunshine for many, but cooler along the east coast. More cloud-cover across Scotland and Northern Ireland will produce some showers. Coastal mist and low cloud in the north, will spread further south later in the day, before spreading inland overnight with isolated pockets of light drizzle. However, staying mostly clear across western parts.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

On Wednesday, low cloud will clear to reveal some warm sunshine, particularly across southern and western parts. More cloud-cover across northern parts may produce isolated showers. Remaining fine on Thursday with further sunshine, though a few isolated showers may develop.
