

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 10 May 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Many northern areas cold and wet, with some heavy rain and snow over some Scottish hills. Elsewhere, cloudy with some rain, and coastal mist. Becoming brighter across some central and eastern areas and feeling warm despite strong winds. Rain continuing across northern England overnight, perhaps with snow over northern hills later. Turning chilly further north with showers, wintry on hills.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:  
Cloudy and cool with the risk of some showers in eastern England on Friday. Elsewhere, brighter with scattered, mainly light showers, wintry over Scottish hills. Generally dry on Saturday, with bright or sunny intervals. Feeling rather chilly in the breeze.
