Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Frosty and icy in many areas at first with freezing fog patches slow to clear some places. Otherwise, apart from a few showers in the far north, most areas will have dry day with sunny spells although patchy low cloud may persist in areas that started foggy, and some western areas will become more cloudy later.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rain will spread eastwards across all areas Wednesday night, clearing Thursday morning. Some heavy snow is expected across higher ground in the north. Thereafter, breezy but less cold with clear or sunny spells and scattered scattered showers, most of the showers in the west.
