Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
There'll be further spells of rain across Scotland and Northern Ireland but with some drier and brighter spells as well. Windy in the north and west with gales. England and Wales mostly cloudy with only a few brighter spells in the north. Mostly dry, but with a little rain or drizzle in places, especially southern and western coasts and hills. Temperatures generally above normal.
Tonight, rain will clear eastwards but with showers developing in the west. There'll be gales in the north.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Windy with squally showers and sunny intervals on Sunday, a risk of stormy weather Monday with damaging winds.
