Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
A cold and bright start for many, with showers in the north and west of the country clearing through the day leaving everywhere fine. Winds will ease, making it feel reasonably pleasant in the sunshine. Overnight it will stay dry with a widespread frost in the south and east. Cloud and patchy rain will arrive in the northwest by dawn.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Through Thursday and Friday, rain in northwestern areas will turn heavy and persistent, accompanied with strong winds and gales. Further south, brighter and drier conditions will prevail, with variable amounts of cloud and sunny spells. Feeling milder than recent days.
