Headline:

Wet, windy weather affecting northwestern parts, moving southeast on Tuesday.

This Evening and Tonight:

Band of locally heavy rain reaching much of Scotland and Northern Ireland overnight, accompanied by gales or severe gales. Windy elsewhere, too, with showers in western areas.

Tuesday:

Wet, windy weather, with gales or severe gales, moving southeast, reaching southeast England during the afternoon. Drier, brighter weather following with wintry showers across northwestern Scotland.

Outlook for Wednesday:

Rain in places. Becoming very windy again.
