Headline:

Warm sunshine developing away from southwestern coasts. Mostly dry overnight.

Today:

Some warm sunshine developing inland. Southwestern coasts will continue rather cloudy with mist and some coastal fog. Thickening cloud will bring patchy rain to Northern Ireland later.

Tonight:

Rather cloudy across northwestern areas with some rain or drizzle, also cloudy down other western coasts, some clear spells inland.

Outlook for Saturday:

Cloudy in the northwest with patchy rain. Dry, sunny, becoming very warm inland.

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
