Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Turning cloudy over much of Scotland, N.Ireland and later the NW of England with some rain. Elsewhere it'll be dry and mainly sunny, apart from the odd shower in the east, but not at all warm for September. The rain will spread to remaining parts of England and Wales tonight while the rest of the UK becomes drier.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Both Wednesday and Thursday will be fairly cloudy at times though some brighter intervals are expected particularly in eastern areas. Showery bursts of rain almost anywhere, and some of these could be heavy at times. Temperatures should be nearer to normal though.
