

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showery rain across northwest Scotland and western Northern Ireland will move southeastwards and slowly fragment, however the odd heavier burst is possible this afternoon. Much of England and Wales will be sunny and very warm. It should remain fairly clear across southeast England tonight, but cloudier elsewhere with occasional light rain or showers, on what will be a mild night.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Mainly dry with some sunny spells developing for most areas on Thursday, with a few heavy showers possible across the Midlands and East Anglia during the afternoon. Friday should also be dry and fairly sunny. Staying warm, with light winds.
