

Forecast For The United Kingdom

at 0700 on Thursday 01 May 2008

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy and showery in the north, but gradually becoming brighter through today. Elsewhere, sunny spells and showers, some heavy and thundery, are expected probably driest over northern England. Showery rain over northern Scotland will gradually ease away tonight, whilst elsewhere will be largely dry with clear spells and light winds, but becoming rather chilly.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Mostly fine initially on Friday, then sunny spells and scattered showers are expected through the day with some heavy and thundery downpours. Locally rather warm. Rain, sometimes heavy, will reach western parts on Saturday with brighter, rather warm, but sometimes showery weather further east.
