Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :  
Sleet or snow across the Midlands will spread over southeast England with rain following and some icy patches likely. Brighter, drier weather in the north is gradually extending elsewhere, with occasional blustery showers. Staying rather cold.  
Mostly dry with clear spells and widespread frost inland tonight. Blustery, wintry showers will affect northern Scotland and eastern coasts though.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:  
Sleet or snow in the east on Saturday, locally heavy, will spread inland at times. Drier and brighter in the west.  
Mainly dry, but rather cloudy, on Sunday. Sunniest in the southwest. Isolated, light snow showers may affect eastern England. Generally rather cold.
