

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Friday 10 Sep 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloudy with rain across much of the UK, though drier, brighter and warmer conditions should prevail towards southern and southeastern England. Wet and breezy for western areas throughout, particularly over higher ground and in the south of Wales. It should, however, become drier later in northeast England, eastern Scotland and Northern Ireland. Brisk southwesterly winds easing slightly overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

The rain will gradually clear southeastwards during Saturday, leaving sunshine and showers for most. Sunday should be mainly dry and bright, although northwest Scotland will turn cloudier and windier with some rain later. Near normal temperatures will feel warm in any sunshine.
