

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 1945 on Sunday 03 Dec 2006

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain, locally heavy, over Scotland, accompanied by gales. Rain and gales decreasing over Northern Ireland. Showers elsewhere, chiefly in western districts, becoming less frequent and heavy in south as cloud increases. Rain dying out during morning over Scotland and gales easing. Elsewhere, showers dying out, then rain, locally heavy, sweeping rapidly northeastwards across most districts followed by strong southwesterly winds.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Tuesday, strong to gale force winds and squally showers in south, more cloudy over Scotland and Northern Ireland with outbreaks of rain. Wednesday, windy with showers in morning, wintry on Scottish hills. Drier, mostly sunny afternoon. Colder than of late.
