Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Cloud will lift and break from most areas but linger in the east of the UK, where it will feel cool. The warmest and sunniest weather will be in the west, but a few showers may develop in northwestern Britain. These should ease overnight leaving some clear spells but low cloud will spread inland again from the east.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:  
Generally fine on Monday with some sunshine and a few showers in northwestern Britain. Cloud and patchy rain may spread to the west of the UK by evening giving damp and breezy weather here on Tuesday but probably staying fine further east.
