Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
There will be outbreaks of rain across Northern Ireland, southern Scotland, northern England and north Wales, occasionally heavy and persistent. To the south it will become mostly dry after a damp start, although staying dull and rather misty. Parts of northern Scotland, although rather wet, may see some drier, brighter spells for a time during the day. Milder everywhere.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
England and Wales will have occasional rain on Tuesday, the north brighter with scattered showers. On Wednesday, after a bright, dry start in the east, heavy rain and strong winds will sweep quickly eastwards. Temperatures will be near normal.
