

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 15 Jul 2010

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain over Scotland should gradually ease throughout the day. Elsewhere, bright spells and scattered heavy and possibly thundery showers are expected, with persistent rain and strong southwesterly winds spreading into southwestern parts of the UK from mid-afternoon. Overnight, rain will continue to spread northeast across remaining parts of the UK, turning heavy over Northern Ireland but clearing southwestern parts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Much drier, with only occasional light rain or showers and plenty of bright or sunny spells. Winds should be lighter across all but northwestern parts of the UK, and it will feel warm in any sunshine, despite near normal temperatures.
