Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Mostly dry and bright at first. Thickening cloud will bring rain, sometimes heavy, to the southwest this morning, becoming widespread this afternoon. Heavy rain across Northern Ireland, northern England and southern Scotland, will spread to Wales and western England overnight. Cloudy with occasional rain elsewhere. Becoming windy today, with gales, especially in the west. Temperatures around normal.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Wet, windy weather over Wales and western England will push across to eastern England, leaving dry, bright weather behind. Showery across Scotland and N.Ireland. Windy. A mostly fine, dry start on Tuesday, but showers over western coasts will become widespread. Breezy. Fairly cool.
