Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
A frosty start in the south but most parts will be rather cloudy with some rain, or even hill snow at first, edging south, becoming light and sporadic. Brighter and more showery in north later. Windy in most parts, and feeling cold, especially in cloudier south.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday will be mostly dry sunny spells and just isolated showers, with the chilly winds easing down. Rain will reach northwestern areas later and this spreads to most parts of the country on Monday, although very little will reach southwestern areas. Becoming less cold.
