

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 10 Dec 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
There will be widespread gales for the northern half of the UK, perhaps up to storm force across exposed northwestern coasts. There will also be blustery wintry showers, with thunder possible, and with snow likely across northern parts at times. Southeastern parts drier with the best of the sunshine.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Windy with wintry showers at first on Thursday, with the best of the sunshine in the east. Rain then spreads from the southwest, perhaps with hill snow over central parts, before clearing on Friday. Showers will then follow, becoming wintry to increasingly lower levels through the day.
