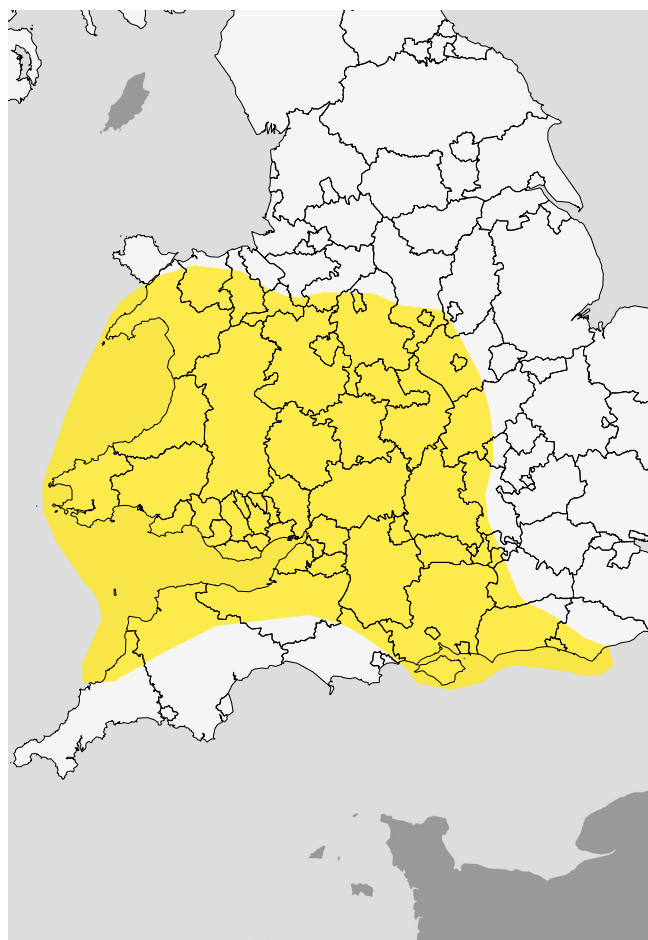




Yellow warning Rain

Between
18:00 Sun 1 Apr 2018 and
16:00 Mon 2 Apr 2018



Heavy rain is expected to affect parts of England and Wales.

What to expect

- Bus and train services probably affected with journey times taking longer
- Spray and flooding on roads probably making journey times longer
- There is a chance of flooding in a few homes and business

Further details

Rain and transient hill snow will spread northwards later on Sunday. Rain will become heavy and persistent for a time before easing from the south during Monday morning. 15-25 mm of rain is likely widely, with 30-50 mm possible locally in parts of South Wales. Some temporary snow is likely over the higher ground early on Monday morning, mainly in Wales and above 400 m, where 2-5 cm could accumulate before snow turns back to rain.
