Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Southern parts will see the hottest day of the year so far with plenty of  
sunshine on offer, as scattered showers affect much of Scotland and Northern  
Ireland. It will then be a dry and clear night for many, but fog patches may  
form around the coasts of the Southwest, as showers continue to affect northwest  
Scotland.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Dry and sunny at first on Monday, but cloud amounts will increase bringing rain  
into Northern Ireland, western Scotland and northwest England by the evening.  
The showery rain continues to affect central parts on Tuesday, whilst sunny  
spells develop elsewhere.
