Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Fog, across many southern parts, will linger into this afternoon in parts of southeast England. Otherwise, much of southern England and southeast Wales will be dry, sunny but chilly. Further northwest, it will be rather cloudy with occasional rain, but also much milder, despite a brisk breeze, and northern Scotland should be brighter later.

Tonight, frost and fog will return to many southern parts but a westerly breeze will keep northwestern parts milder with cloud and drizzle at times.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Fog for a time in the southeast but generally milder, rain at times but also some dry, bright weather for most.
